
Minnesota State Youth Camp - JUNIOR CAMP June 9-14, 2024 for students entering grades 4-8



What is Minnesota State Junior Youth Camp?

Junior Camp is a one week experience for youth entering grades 4 – 8 designed to help them experience and learn about God, Jesus, and the Christian life. Activities will include classes, workshops, recreation, and worship.

*Students entering 9th grade may attend Senior Camp from June 14-15.



Church of God Doctrinal Statement

The following Scriptural truths are considered fundamental in the proclamation of the gospel message:

- 1. The unity and supremacy of God (Mark 12:29-30)
- 2. Jesus Christ is the Son of God and the only Savior of mankind (John 3:13-18)
- 3. The Kingdom of God will be established in the future on earth, with Christ as King of Kings (Luke 1:31-33; Revelation 19:16)
- 4. Christ will return to earth to rule all nations, restore the nation of Israel, raise the dead and judge the world in righteousness (Acts1:11; Matthew 25:31; Romans 11:25, 26; 1 Corinthians 15:22; Acts17:31)
- 5. Resurrection of the dead to future life (1 Corinthians 15:12-23)
- 6. Destruction of the wicked (Psalm 37; Revelation 20:12-15)
- 7. Eternal life only through the Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 6:23)
- 8. Belief, repentance and baptism (immersion) in the name of Jesus Christ and a consecrated life are essential to salvation (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38, 39; Romans 6)

Expectations for Campers

In order to maintain an atmosphere that allows all in attendance to experience God and fellowship with others in a safe and supportive Christian environment, campers must agree to abide by the following rules. **Campers and their parents/guardians must sign the agreement portion of the application form that states they have read, understand and agree to these rules**:

- 1. My behavior will not cause a problem for other campers or staff.
- 2. I will participate in all planned activities.
- 3. I will not bring to camp tobacco products of any kind or any substance which would be illegal for me to possess. Any such items will be confiscated. The camp and its staff will not be responsible for confiscated items.
- 4. If I am a male, I will not go into the female cabin area, and if I am a female, I will not go into the male cabin area (even if I think I have a good reason), except at designated times for specific classes and with staff supervision.
- 5. I understand that my cell phone must be checked in with my counselor and can only be used with their permission. I will not bring to camp any electronic equipment to play games on, because I will not have time to do that!
- 6. I will dress in clothing that is appropriate for the activities in which I participate.
 - I will wear shoes at all times.
 - I will not wear a bikini swimsuit (unless I am covered by a t-shirt) and my swimsuit will be appropriate for my age.
 - I will not wear clothing with inappropriate pictures/messages.
 - I will wear clothing that properly covers my undergarments.

If there is any question about whether or not my wardrobe choices meet these guidelines, the determination will be made by camp counselors. I will respect their judgment
